As we have mentioned previously, the State Fire Marshal has enacted rules for continuing education hours for the Fire Inspector 1 certification. For anyone that had this certificate prior to summer of 2017, your recertification year is 2021. For everyone who receives this certification in the future, your recertification will be four years from when the certificate was issued. The certification requirements were modeled after the fire investigators. It needs to be noted that the IFIA mini seminars and the annual conference **WILL** count towards those needed hours.

If you have an interest in becoming a youthful firesetter interventionist, contact the OSFM. There are still classes available for this.
